#### QUAD SCANS INSTEAD OF FULL ARCH

Partial scans increase likelihood of high occlusion and open bites, as well as inability to match contralateral contours.

#### **UNCLEAR OR INCOMPLETE MARGINS**

The #1 reason for remakes - if we can't see the margin on our screen, our crown margin is an educated guess at best.

#### **VAGUE PRESCRIPTIONS**

Missing patient information could lead to guesswork, not precision.

## 7 Actionable Tips for Flawless Digital Impressions

- 1. USE DOUBLE-PACK RETRACTION CORD Creates ideal margin visibility – the foundation of perfect restorations.
- 2. ENSURE SCANS ARE DEBRIS-FREE Digital scanners capture EVERYTHING – including blood, moisture, and debris.
- 3. REVIEW YOUR SCANS BEFORE SUBMISSION Take an extra minute to check for missing areas, distortions, or artifacts.
- 4. SUBMIT FULL ARCH SCANS WHEN POSSIBLE Provides complete context for proper fit, alignment, and function.

- 5. AVOID MULTIPLE SCANS OF THE SAME AREA Creates overlapping data that complicates processing.
- 6. SUBMIT SCANS IMMEDIATELY Keeps workflow moving and prevents delays.
- 7. PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE PATIENT DETAILS Note grinding habits, aesthetic preferences, and specific challenges.
